The SRHC REB is an autonomous body that has been established and granted authority by the Southlake Board of Directors to protect the rights, safety and well-being of study participants (including patients, staff, physicians, volunteers) who participate in research conducted under the auspices of Southlake Regional Health Centre

In 2016, the SRHC REB was the first community hospital research ethics board in Ontario to achieve “CTO (Clinical Trials Ontario) Qualified REB” designation

Clinical Trials Ontario...

- CTO has led the movement for a streamlined provincial ethics review system for multi-centered clinical trials in Ontario
- As a “CTO Qualified REB” the SRHC REB provides ethical review and oversight for multiple research sites across the province participating in the same clinical trial
